


Danny sends his apologies for not being able to send an article for January. He has been out of town due to job responsibilities, but praises God that he has a job to go to each day!

### "INMATE RELEASE CLOTHING".

In January of 2012, the Mission Team at FUMC Beeville adopted a plan to provide clothing for men being released from McConnell Unit in Beeville, it is simply called "Inmate Release Clothing". Men are released from TDCJ to go back to their homes or cities of origin through the Release Programs at McConnell. Approximately 20% of these men have no families available or able to bring them clothing to wear on their way home. We have been working to meet this need and would like to invite you to be a part of this ministry through acts of kindness that reflect you ur love for and of Jesus Christ. In Matthew 25:36, Jesus says," I was in prison and you came to me." I was shivering and you gave me clothes.'

The contact at TDCJ lets Andrea know when and what is needed. Dozens of people from SA and CC have already helped, hundreds of shirts and trousers have been provided in these 8 months, but more are needed.
