

One of my favorite pieces of a psalm is the 30th which reminds us "for his anger is but for a moment, his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may linger for the night, but joy comes with the morning." So we should not spend too much time emphasizing on the "Whys?" which question the strength of our faith. We should be spending more time on the joys of our faith, the times that come and go so fast where God has blessed us and moved us to share our faith. I find it supportive in my faith walk to hear of what God is doing since my walk AND what I am going to do about it. Yes, life moves on, so fast. But life is moving on with an awesome God walking beside us through the valleys of the shadow of death AND the mountaintops of "walking with God.
