

Easter People! Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! I trust you are all well in the peace and knowledge of the Resurrection of Christ from the dead to bring new life to all who call upon His name!

As I write this, I am still on the emotional roller coaster from the Men's Walk. What a powerful display of the redemptive power of God in the lives of these men! I shared at closing that I have worked many walks and ALWAYS God has worked in mighty ways. But this walk was different. Not that God didn't work in mighty ways - but it was different in that the devil seemed to be working overtime to destroy what was being knit together for the "best walk ever!" A month out, we celebrated the first FULL Men's Walk since 1997, I think it was. This was the first time that we had a full slate of pilgrims with standbys BEFORE the walk began. leaving behind a grieving family and community. A few days before the Walk, we received word that one of our pilgrim's mother had died and he was not going to be able to attend. While on the Walk, another pilgrim received word his mother was gravely ill and not expected to live through the evening. During the FIRST talk, I was called out of the conference room to talk with one of the pilgrims who had left the room distressed. This pilgrim shared how he was awaken in the middle of the night with the devil breathing down his neck – telling him he had no business being there. He went on to share with me the war going on inside of him of wanting to leave behind his old "wicked" life and walk with God and how his family and friends were angry with him for "changing his ways." I pray A LOT on the Walk, but I think this Walk may have set some sort of praying record!

I share this with you because we are called as disciples to lift one another up in good times and bad. And not just for the Walks, but for all the time. God doesn't just work in the hearts and minds of the pilgrims and the team on a specific weekend twice a year. And nor does the devil. God works all the time...and so does the devil. Those of us who understand the power of God in our lives, know we must be diligent as the hands and hearts and mouthpiece of Christ at all times and that our brothers and sisters need to hear from us continually.

I hope you will take seriously your commitment to Christ and to our newest brothers and sisters in the community. Pray without ceasing. Lift one another up encouraging, supporting and sustaining one another in the Word and Holy Spirit. Let us continue to work together to keep the devil in his place and to lift up the glory of God in and through Jesus Christ!




