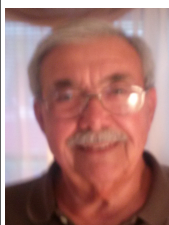

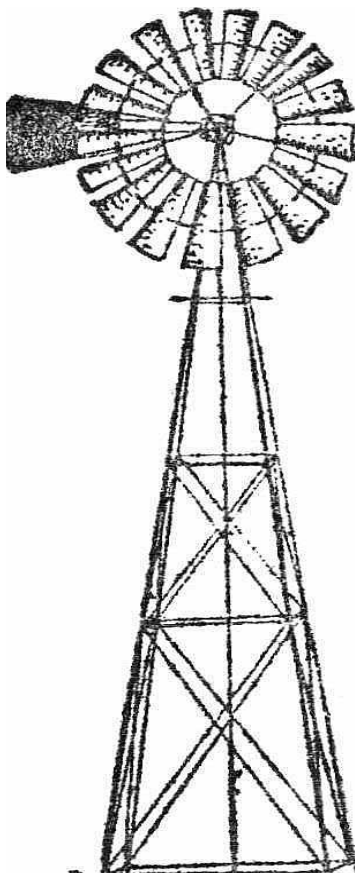
Hello Windmill Community!

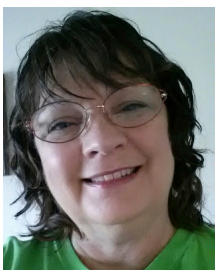
