community.

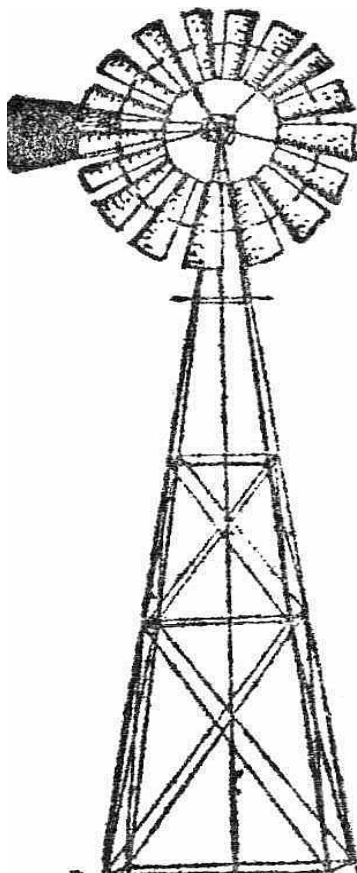
May we all continue to love and

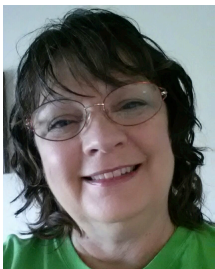
