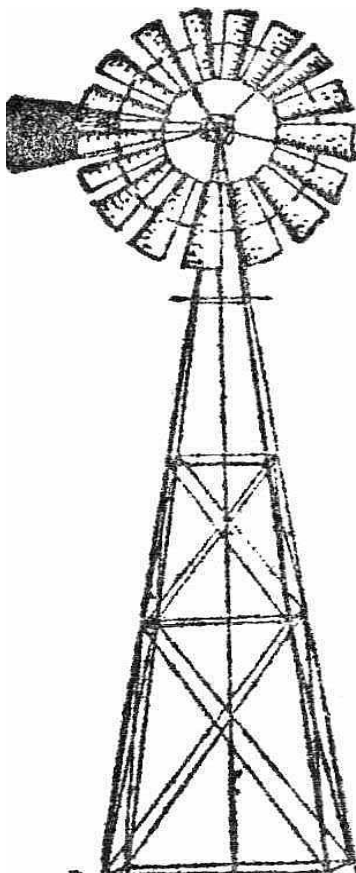


Hello Windmill Community!

John 1:1-18 was a reading for both Christmas Day and for the Second Sunday after Christmas, which was January 3, 2016. It is a story of God's grace coming into our lives through the gift of salvation that Christ offers to each of us and to all of us. The WORD was at the same time as God's creation and the WORD, Jesus, is forever.

Sometimes in our thinking we forget the special opportunity we have to pass on God's gift to strangers we might meet and to our own family. This is a part of the message of EMMAUS. the most renowned pianists of the day come to Budapest. Emil von Sauer was famous not only for his abilities, but he was also the last surviving pupil of the great Franz Liszt. Von Sauer requested that Foldes play for him. Foldes obliged with some of the most difficult works of Bach, Beethoven, and Schumann. When he finished, von Sauer walked over to him and kissed him on the forehead. “My son,” he said, “when I was your age I became a student of Liszt. He kissed me on the forehead after my first lesson, saying ‘Take good care of this kiss—it comes from Beethoven, who gave it to me after hearing me play.’ I have waited for years to pass on the sacred heritage, but now I feel you deserve it.” We have a marvelous treasure in earthen vessels; let us pass the Holy Kiss of our faith to one more deserving student of Jesus.
