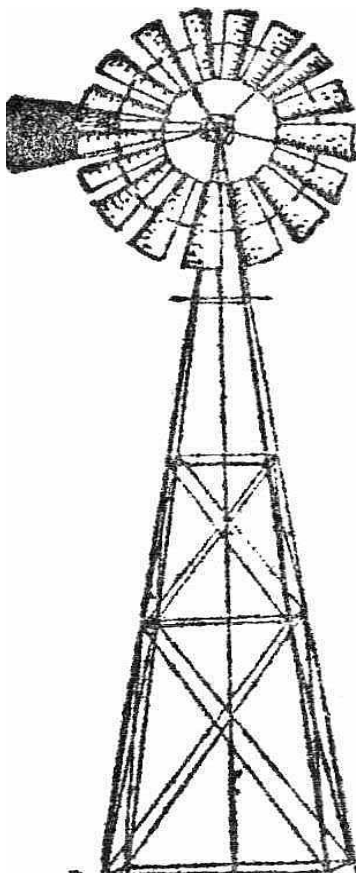
Hello Windmill Community!

HELLO, WINDMILL EMMAUS COMMUNITY

We have been the Windmill
Fourth Day Group under the
Southwest Texas Conference of
the United Methodist Church for
a number of years and have
conducted over 60 walks as a
part of that large Emmaus
Community. Shortly after the
Rio Texas Conference came into
existence the connection
between Conference and
Emmaus communities began to
take on new form. As you read
this, we will be one of the first
three groups to become an
Emmaus community under the
direction of the Upper Room in
Nashville. More communities
are being formed as their
paperwork is completed. What
will change in all of this may not
seem like much more than a
name change. But we will now
be **responsible in all ways** for
the success of our community.
Registrations for walks will be
done locally and we will fully
fund the walks. We will
maintain a list of clergy that are
approved for walk spiritual
leadership. Team selection will
choose members for the two

Walks as they have done in the past. And we will be responsible to see all leadership is current in their training. We have been known as a community that follows the plan of the Walk to Emmaus. We have 11 churches that sponsor our monthly Gatherings and the pastors and lay people of these churches make sure that all parts of the Gathering are prepared from meal to communion elements to the facilities. We are thankful to these churches who have been dedicated to this extension of our Emmaus Community. It is not a simple thing to do so, especially for the churches that sponsor immediately after a walk or before when we do Team Consecration. These four gatherings annually are large attendance events.

I am proud of the direction that I have seen our community go in the years that I have been involved. In December I will complete a two and a half year stint as Community Spiritual Director and will have served in this position numerous times since 2003 having been either an Assistant Community SD or the Community SD that entire time. New clergy community leadership will come from the eleven clergy who are a part of our community.

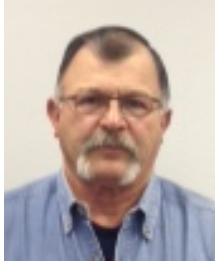
