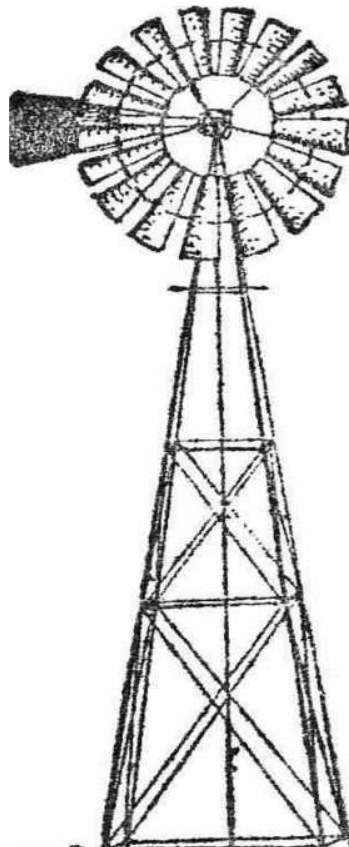
Windmill Emmaus,
