



reading has approached the  
same event from two different  
Gospel writers and two  
slightly different accountings.  
Both involve crossing the Sea  
of Galilee and both involve  
overworked followers of  
Jesus. In between we have  
special emphases. On July 19  
the focus was on overworked  
and underpaid disciples who  
“did not even have enough  
leisure to eat” (they never  
were at an Emmaus  
gathering). And the story  
exemplified compassionate  
love for the needy of our  
community. Our Emmaus  
community has many who  
need our prayers as they are  
fighting health issues, work  
issues, and horrible cancers.

The July 26<sup>th</sup> story adds the feeding of the 5,000, which was left out of July 19<sup>th</sup> reading. But there are those sinners who are sick and who need healing all of the time and there is the famous story that storms can come up quickly on the Sea of Galilee and being tossed about in a boat on the sea is NOT fun.

Notice that whichever week we are in and whether we are in Mark or John no one is turned away. There is NO sin so great that God cannot forgive. We go into dying moments to affirm that. Some of us go to the priest and privately confess our sins so we can know that. And yet there are others who are burdened, because they feel that God “surely could not forgive” what I have done, so, why even ask.

Well, ask away! Our God is bigger than we sometimes give him credit when it comes to forgiveness and grace.


1. To get in team apps if you would like to serve. If you're not sure, please pray about it. Don't forget, each team member is responsible for his own team fee of \$210.
