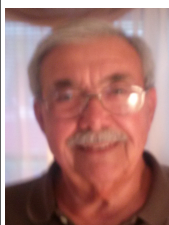

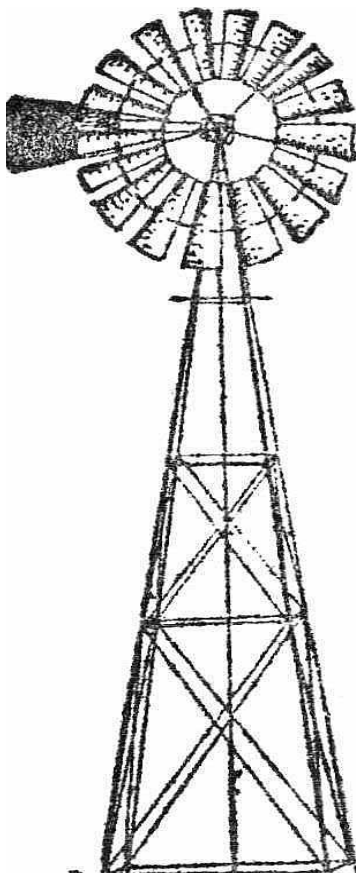

THE PROCESS OF SAYING, “GODSPEED”

We have been hearing over the past two months in many of our churches the movement from Easter to the Pentecost season in which the stories have been about the Resurrected Jesus preparing his disciples for his departure, the Day of the Ascension, and the coming of the Holy Spirit.
