
Howdy Windmill Emmaus,

Dear Emmaus Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that all may see your progress." --- 1 Timothy 4:15.

This verse offers a truth about our journey of faith in Jesus Christ. Each of us come to the moment of faith. The Holy Spirit awakens in us the revealing truth of who Jesus is and his role in ushering to our very lives God's gracious gift of grace.
