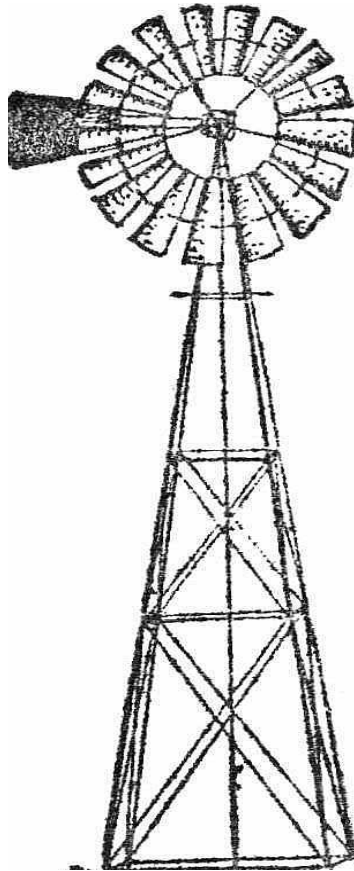

*“Come to Christ, the living Stone—rejected by human beings but chosen by God and precious to him. You also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.” ~ 1 Peter 2:4-5,9*

In the courtyard of the church I grew up in there is a mosaic dove surrounded by regular brick in a wheel pattern. I would sit for hours spending quality time with God around that dove. It is a sacred place where I could feel God’s presence in the brokenness of my life. As I sat, I was always amazed at the ways that the pieces worked together to form something beautiful. I imagined what the dove looked like before the artist shaped and formed the dove. Was there individual stacks separated by color and hue or a big pile of jumbled mess. Did the jagged edges of the stone cut at the artists hands. In this passage Paul calls us a holy priesthood. A priest is a mediator, or bridge, between God and human beings. In ancient times the priest offered sacrifices on behalf of all people. Once a year, on the day of Atonement the Jewish high priest went into the Holy of Holies in the Temple to commune with God.
