Boy I wish that someone would have gagged me. My poor choice of words that were going to show them how it should have been done went well beyond that and became a personal attack.

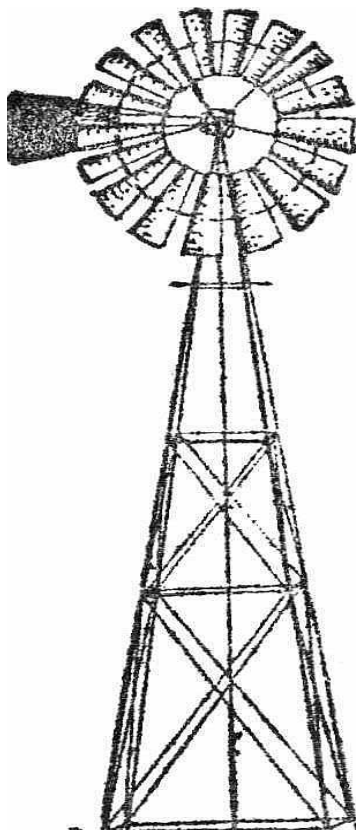
Proverbs 18:21 Words kill, words give life; they're either poison or fruit- your choice.
