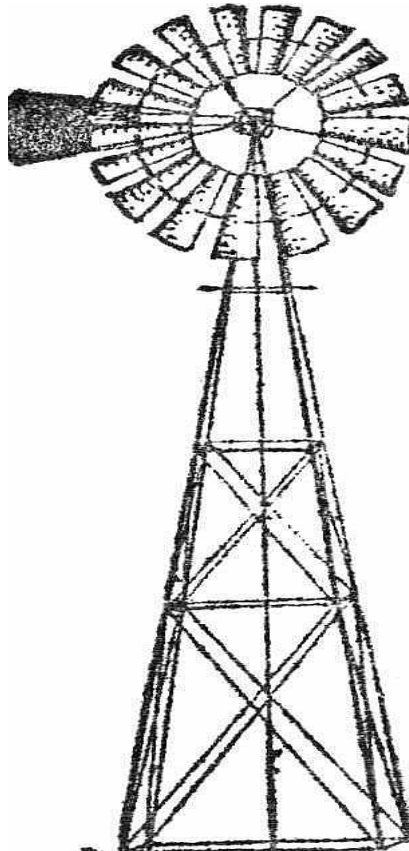
I am excited to be serving as the Community Lay Director!! I look forward to serving with you all and I pray 2022 will be a blessed year for each one of you!!

to hurt anymore and SO THAT we know that God loves and cares for us. In 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 we hear that the SO THAT goes beyond us to the ways that we can be an instrument of grace for others to experience God's compassion and comfort.

In spite of human frailties and failures, in spite of all the brokenness we bring with us, heaven intersects with life here on earth when we show compassion to others. We each can do something to make this a reality.

Who is God bringing into your life that is going through trouble? How can YOU be a tangible expression of God's grace to help strengthen and support them in that trouble?

Recently a friend of mine was hospitalized and in rehab facilities for months following a hip replacement surgery that didn't go well. He felt like God had put him in that place SO THAT he had the opportunity to encourage and pray for the nurses and other patients, even though he was in constant, intense pain. People were amazed that he had so much compassion for others. Your experiences in life have put you in a place where you might be the perfect position for the compassion someone needs.

Lent is the 40 days leading into Easter where we celebrate the resurrection power of Jesus. In these lenten days, let's concentrate on the ways that God is calling us to help to comfort others. Look with new eyes for the people around and their need for compassion.
