October has arrived!! Fall is in the air and temperatures are just a little cooler than they have been!!

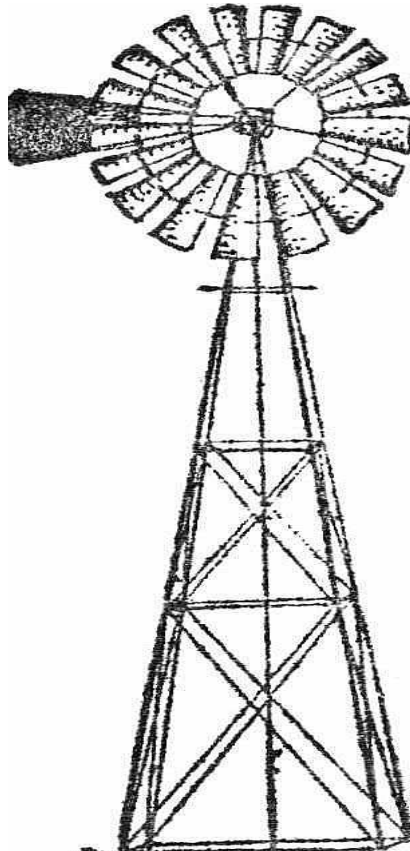
