


Greetings Emmaus Brothers and Sisters:

after my walk that I gave up being a baby chick.

It wasn't long after reintroduction to Emmaus that the Community Spiritual Director invited me to become the only Assistant Community Spiritual Director. I have been a Walk Spiritual director and sat at the table of St. Elsewhere in the assistants' role. In the ensuing years, I have served a number of years as Community Spiritual Director. All of this because I am a strong ecumenist and I love my brothers and sisters in Emmaus no matter what our church background is for we are connected to the true vine. I keep a low profile often in areas that I think will be more divisive than unifying. That is how we should work in a Church that has so many differences and understandings of scripture and how we are called differently to "love God and love our disenfranchised neighbor". I am a firm believer that we need to stay connected to "the way, the truth, and the life". But in the chaos of the ongoing development of being Church we can be tempted to replace "the vine" with disconnected branches. We need to remember that "Christ is counting on us".

I urge you, to follow your reading of this article by reading slowly the entire 15th chapter of the Gospel of John. You have heard the first part referenced in a couple of talks on your pilgrim walk or each time you worked on the inside team on the walk. Remember Christ says, ¹⁶You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last.
