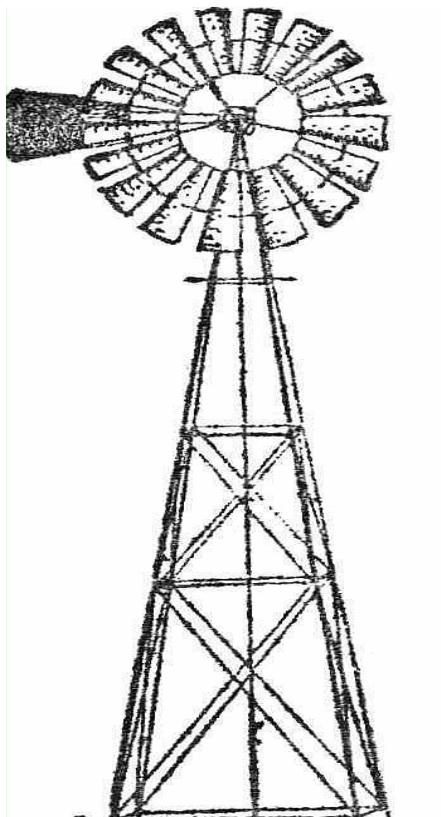


Dear Windmill Emmaus Brothers and Sisters:

for persons who would like to work on the team. The requirements to work on a team are for you to have attended a pilgrim Walk to Emmaus or another comparable walk and to complete a Servant Application before the deadline which will be before Team Selection is held for this Walk. You need to be committed to attending all the Team Meetings and being available for the entire 72 hour walk scheduled from 10:00 a.m. on Thursday morning to around 5:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon. The dates for Walk #77 are Oct. 3-6, 2024. The fees to work a Walk and/or to sponsor a pilgrim are \$240. Remember these fees cover your room and board at Camp Zephyr for these 72 hours.

Of course, Thanksgiving is on Nov. 23, 2023. I am so thankful for the opportunity to have been sponsored to go on my pilgrim Walk #1598 in 2011, to have been able to work on many inside and outside teams on both Men's and Women's Walks, to serve as a Board member for many years serving as Board Secretary and as Community Lay Director in 2023, to serve on the Team Selection Committee, and to serve as Women's Lay Director of Walk #71 in 2021.
