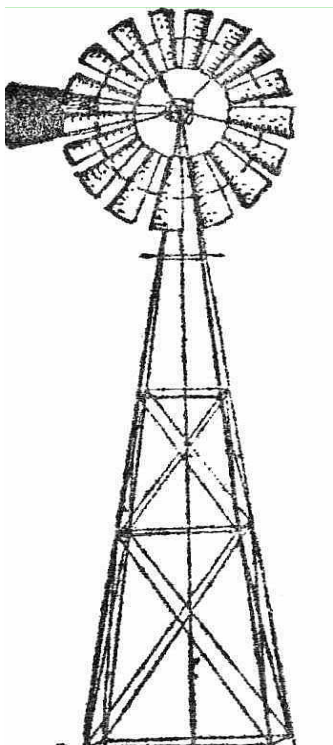

A few thoughts to share. What an amazing and blessed experience to know the scriptures are alive and always leading us. As I prepared for Sunday service I realized not only was Jesus, The Shepherd but also The Gate. I knew He was but put in the context of John 10. He is both at once while calling us to be the small "s" shepherds. We, working through His power and authority, are to bring other sheep into the sheepfold as they hear His voice and see Him through our testimonies. He is the voice to train our ear to hear and follow. The Shepherd is calling His sheep. He is calling us as His sheep to come to the sheepfold, into the pen, to be fed, to be watered, to be nurtured, and protected. He warns that not all shepherds are of Him. The false shepherds come to lie, steal, and destroy trying to lead the sheep into darkness and false hope. We as His disciples, His shepherds, are called to bring other sheep into the herd and through The Gate. The one true Gate to salvation and a full life in Christ following The Shepherd. You see the Gate is a real thing, as Jesus taught, He is the way, the truth, and the life. The only way to the Father is through the Son, Jesus Christ. Through the Gate which lets the sheep in and out as an

who sets the guidelines called a Covenant that we must comply with as part of an international entity and our local Board of Directors sets our Windmill Emmaus Board By-Laws each year which must be followed, also.

Potential Team Members must complete a Lay Team Application and meet a set deadline for submission. All team applications then go through a Team Selection Committee selection process. Team members chosen for all inside teams fall under the One – Third Rule with approximately one-third new conference room team members, second-time or third-time team members, and team veterans.

Outside Team Members with no experience are usually placed on the team and then team members are chosen based on who else has applied. Once a team is chosen, the twelve inside team members are paired into Team Leaders and Assistant Team Leaders and the ten talks are assigned to them. The other five talks are assigned to the five Clergy on the Walk. Outside Team Members are not assigned talks. Team meetings are scheduled on four or five Sats. during the months before the Walk takes place. Team members must adhere to attendance guidelines. If a team member misses too many meetings, they will be replaced by an alternate who applied for the team.

Other guidelines govern how persons are chosen for leadership roles and will be explained at a later date. We look forward to anyone who would like to be involved in the next Men's Walk to Emmaus # 82 to begin applying now. Remember, the next Men's Team will be chosen by the Team Selection Committee a few weeks before the Women's Team #81 Walk date on Oct. 1-4, 2026.
