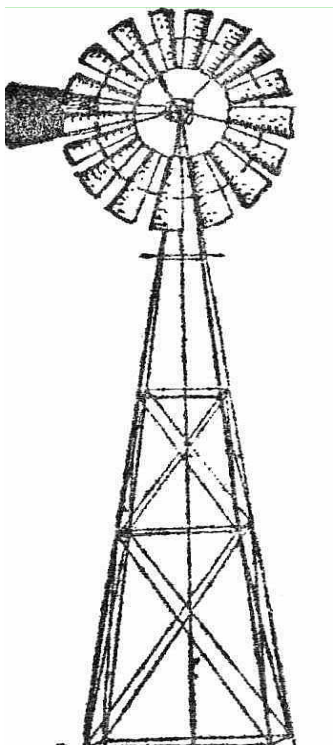

Greetings Windmill Emmaus Brothers and Sisters:
Wow! This year is zooming by. When this article is published in the June Breeze, we will have completed the one-half-year mark of 2026 for our Windmill Emmaus Community. We have completed half of the Walks, hosted half of the pilgrims, and hosted half of the Gatherings we will host this year. This month marks the half-year mark of me serving as your Windmill Emmaus Community Lay Director, as well. I am already reflecting on what we as a Board and as a Community have accomplished and what we still need to accomplish this year. I think it is my responsibility to educate community members on different aspects of Emmaus. I think sharing knowledge is a very integral and important aspect of continuing and improving our Community. Community Members will then have the knowledge to make informed decisions on whether they would like to serve in these capacities or not.

This month, I would like to share information about our Emmaus Leadership Team. Our Windmill Emmaus Board is composed of seventeen members. All seventeen of these members make a three- year commitment to attend all eleven Gatherings

Have you heard God calling? Have you seen the work of Christ in your midst? Have you been in the presence of the Holy Spirit? The answer is "YES"! You are answering the call, you are looking to join Christ in His work, and you are living in the presence of the Spirit. You are, but you are also being beat up by chaos of darkness, being pulled by the flesh, and experiencing the taunting of satan himself. I have had it on my heart lately that in the moments of our greatest experiences in our Christian walk, our Fourth Days, we struggle in life at times. Some of us struggle more than others, some of us struggle in silence, and some of us fold under the nagging of life's demons. I have come to believe that the harder we long for a close and working relationship with God; the harder the devil moves in and around us to draw us away from God. The demons linger, pulling at our hearts and minds to draw us into confusion and doubt, creating a distraction from our Father. Why does this happen? We are children of the Most High so, why should we have any troubles or temptations? Well, that is the very reason. Think about it, the devil doesn't have to worry about the ones who are lost and are not living with God. He already has

held during the year and serve as our community representatives. Our Board is composed of five Clergy who have had to undergo certain guidelines to be able to serve as an Emmaus Pastor. Four of them serve as Assistance Spiritual Directors. Our Leader is known as the Community Spiritual Director. The CSD leads all worship during the Gatherings according to the Upper Room Guidelines which we follow in our purple books. They are responsible for setting up Communion and consecrating the Communion Elements. They are responsible for choosing communion servers according to our guidelines. They are responsible for sharing Scripture and encouraging words when we do not have a Fourth Day Speaker. They are responsible for prayer during the Gatherings. They are responsible for writing an article for the Breeze each month according to our guidelines. They are responsible for ensuring all of our Pastors who work Walks meet the criterion for leading in that capacity.

The four Assistant Spiritual Directors should attend all Board Meetings and Gatherings. They fill in for the CSD, if they are absent. They are eligible to serve as ASD on Walks and if they meet all the criterion, they may serve as CSD on Walks.

The Community Lay Director is a person on the Board who has served the previous year as the Assistant Community Lay Director. The CLD makes sure the Board, the Community, and the Walks follow the Upper Room Covenant and the WEC By-Laws. The CLD oversees all Board Meetings, creates the agenda for all Board meetings according to the needs of the community and of walks, and attends all functions hosted by the Community. The CLD does not have to have served as a Lay Director previously, but it is very helpful to have that experience.

The Assistant Community Lay Director serves in the capacity of the CLD, if the CLD is unable to attend a meeting or an event. The ACLD creates the Gathering Schedule for the next year before September, so the schedule can be approved at that meeting and be ready to be placed in the Women's Walk Pilgrims' 4th Day Packets in October. The ACLD contacts all churches on the Gathering Schedule to inquire if they have a praise team to lead worship. If the church doesn't, then the ACLD is responsible for finding someone to lead worship. They need to ask the band or individuals playing music if the Emmaus Song Books are needed or if they will have a Power Point. If the songbooks are needed, they need to contact the person who brings the books to the Gatherings. They need to make sure the church has a room for the Board to meet, has a meal, desserts, and drinks planned, has two Communion Serving Sets (plates, chalices, and cloth napkins), and is willing to provide the Communion Elements. If the church does not have two sets of Communion Serving Elements, then they need to let Tanya and Christi know to bring the Emmaus sets. If the Church needs Emmaus to furnish the Communion Elements, they need to let the CSD or the CLD know they need to bring them. If the church needs the meal to be a potluck meal or if the church needs help with entrees and or desserts, they need to arrange for that help. The ACLD is responsible for securing 4th Day Speakers for Gatherings where they are needed. If there is no 4th Day Speaker, then they need to let the CSD know they will be responsible for sharing the Word. The ACLD needs to let the CSD and the CLD know that everything is ready and in order before the date of the Gathering.

The Board Secretary is responsible for keeping an up-to-date notebook of current Board Agendas, Meeting Minutes, Treasurer's Reports, and other pertinent items. The Secretary should attend every Gathering or make sure that someone is assigned to take notes, read the previous minutes, and chart Board attendance. In the event the Secretary needs to be absent, they should send the previous Board Meeting Minutes with another Board Member.

The Board Treasurer is responsible for creating a monthly Treasurer's Report and sharing it with the Board. The treasurer should attend every Board Meeting or have someone bring their report and give it to the Board. They are eligible to sign checks and are responsible for paying all our license fees, bills, and walk fees. They are responsible for sending thank-you notes for donations made to Emmaus. They are responsible for bringing the collection bowls to the Gathering or sending them with someone. They are responsible for counting the offering collected at all Gatherings and all Candlelight Ceremonies and making bank deposits.

The Board Representative is a very crucial part of our Board. The Board Representative should attend every Board Meeting and other activities sponsored by Windmill Emmaus. They are responsible for keeping us in compliance and knowing Emmaus Covenants, By -Laws, and Upper Room Laws or at least where to find all this information. The Board Representative is in constant communication with the CLD and other members of the Board. The Board Rep. is in charge of all Windmill Emmaus Training, such as Leadership Training and Sponsorship Training. They are the leader of the Education Committee, which is composed of four other WEC Members. The Board Rep is the Leader of the Team Selection Committee and is in charge of keeping records of when members come on and go off of the Committee. They are responsible for making sure that the 1/3, 1/3.1/3 Rule is followed by having a certain number of Veterans Members on a Team, a certain number of medium-experience members, and a certain number of new members. They make a Board Presentation to the Board on pertinent information and to the Community at Gatherings, if need be.

The Board Rep has to stay in close contact with Camp Zephyr to make sure we get the dates we would like secured for the Walks for the next year. The Board Rep talks to persons interested in getting in the progressive servanthood order to ensure they are on the path to becoming a future Lay Director. The Board Rep contacts the Assistant Lay Directors who are eligible to be our next Lay Director to ensure that they are ready to serve in that role. The Board Rep keeps records of Board Members' years of service to determine when they should roll off the Board every three years.

All of our Board Members and Board Officers are very much appreciated and do a great job! May God Bless You All!
