The Sept. 17, 2026 Gathering will be held in George West at the Methodist Church. This Gathering will be Team Consecration for Women's Walk #81. All #81 team members and all community members

should attend to show your support of the team's commitment and to cover the Team in prayer. During this meeting, we will elect four new Board Members who will take office on Jan. 1, 2027.

We will host our second and last Walk of the Year. The date of Women's Walk # 81 is October 1-4, 2026. If you are sponsoring a pilgrim, please have your pilgrim at Camp Zephyr at 6:00 p.m. sharp. Message from Community Spiritual Director

For many years the Book of Revelation would set my heart to racing, my tummy to aching, and my mind spinning looking for reasoning or a rationale for John’s writings in Revelation.
